

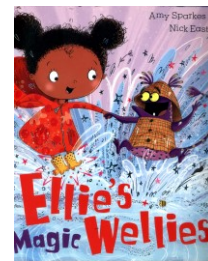
This is a cross curricular topic encompassing all areas of the Early Years Foundation Stage and the Year One Curriculum.

UW/ HISTORY and GEOGRAPHY:

We will be learning about the daily weather patterns in England. We will be learning about continents and oceans. *What is your favourite weather and why?*



CLL/ LITERACY: We will be learning about and listening to different stories linked to the weather. We will be reading *Cloudland* by John Burningham and *Ellie's Magic Wellies* by Amy Sparkes. We will be thinking about story language and will be creating our own storyboards. We will also write weather reports. *Can you find a book linked to the weather?*



EAD/ DESIGN TECHNOLOGY:

We will be using the weather as inspiration for art. We will be using different techniques to create Cloudscape pictures. We will also be creating representational pictures and collages of different weather.

Can you make a picture of your favourite type of weather?



In MATHS

We will be learning about time and the different seasons in the year. We will also learn about capacity and volume. We will investigate how to measure rainfall using a rain gauge. We will continue to count in different multiples.

Vocabulary:

English: beginning, middle, end, story language, reports.

Maths: capacity, volume, litres, millilitres, full, half full, empty, centimetres,

Science: shadows, day length, earth, axis, sun.

Music:

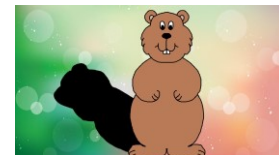
