

Though this is a cross curricular topic; **History and Art are the main points of focus.**

History:

Romans. Who were the Romans? What did they do? Did they influence current times? We will be looking at how the Romans invaded different countries, their lifestyle, their homes and their great inventions.

What do you know about the Romans in the UK? Can we still find evidence they were in this country?

Art:

We will be looking at creating 3-D life size Romans, Roman inspired mosaics and pottery.

What type of pottery did Romans use?

Can we still find Roman poetry now? Where could we find examples of it?



In **LITERACY** we are looking at stories that are humorous (Year 4) and classic fiction (Year 5/6). All three year groups will be at looking at poetry that uses imagery. We will also be looking closely at non-fiction texts and giving instructions using imperative (bossy!) verbs.



Can you find a favorite story in the library or at home that supports our topic?

In **NUMERACY** we are looking at place value and decimal numbers. We will be looking at compact addition and subtraction as well as applying these skills when we are handling money. We will also look at using fractions, doubling and halving.

Can you create a guide to fractions? This might have words and pictures to help!

Romans (Yr 4/5/6 – Autumn Term)

ICT:

As we will be using ICT to support our topic we will be looking at how to create a new font and use programs such as Logo. This look at computer programming will help us to organise our lines of code and ensure we can begin to 'debug' our work.
