



# Our Class Code

Always concentrate on your learning and try your best. Work hard to finish tasks and remain focussed on the task.

If you are distracted you will be reminded to focus on your task. You may be moved to a place where you can concentrate more easily. You may have to catch up with incomplete work.

Always ask for help if you are stuck. You could ask someone on your table or put your hand up.

Always listen to others if they are speaking. Look at the person speaking and let them finish without interrupting.

If you are not listening, you will be reminded of the Class Code and asked to apologise to the person who was speaking.

Always use a quiet voice when learning in class. Remember to put your hand up if you want to speak instead of shouting out.

If you are too loud you will be reminded of the class code. If you shout out, someone with their hand up will be picked before you.

Always be kind to others and their belongings. Use polite words and avoid being rough.

If you are unkind to people you will be asked to say sorry.

Take care with school equipment and share. Put things away where they belong when you are finished.

If you are untidy, you may have to tidy up in your own time.

If you continue not to follow the Class Code you will end up losing some of your break time or possibly some of your *Pick and Mix* time.
