

Though this is a cross curricular topic; **Art and DT are the main points of focus.**

Art/DT:

We will be looking at circus themed art work (including historical and modern art) as well as automata. Our DT work will be all about creating moving models as well as how cams work. We will also be looking at evaluating and improving our work.



What do you know about the circus? What happens in a circus? What might you see?

French:

We will be looking at the language related to family, friends and food. We will be able to talk about the weather using simple phrases.

What are the famous places you could visit in France?

In **LITERACY** we are looking at Classic Fiction in Year 5/6 and stories with humour in Year 4. Year 4/5/6 will be focused on chronological reports and persuasive writing. Year 4 will have a close look at nonsense poetry whilst Year 5/6 will be focused on the work of Emily Dickinson.

In **NUMERACY** we are looking at place value, addition, subtraction and Roman numerals. We will then move onto area and perimeter and touch upon co-ordinates.

As we will be using ICT to support our topic we will be looking at how to use 3-D modelling to support our DT work. This will use a variety of programmes to help us understand how planning and modelling can be used across many different real life jobs.

We are going to be looking closely at different habitats around us and the types of animals that live there. We will be looking at different types of animals and their classifications as well as thinking about food chains.
