

This is a cross curricular topic encompassing all areas of the Early Years Foundation Stage and the Year One Curriculum.

UW/ HISTORY and GEOGRAPHY:

We will be learning about the history of medicine. We will investigate how bugs are used for medicinal purposes.

EAD/ DESIGN TECHNOLOGY:

We will be learning about Artist Andy Goldsworthy We will create sculptures using the natural materials in the



environment. We will experiment with clay to make bugs. We will also be looking closely at the markings on different bugs and represent these using different materials.

Can you make a natural sculpture using materials found in the outside environment?

CLL/ LITERACY: We will be listening to and retelling stories linked to Bugs. The books will include 'The Munching Crunching Caterpillar' by Sheridan Cain and 'The Bear and the Bees' by Ella Richardson. We will write bug 'What Am I?' poems. We will continue to work on making our handwriting beautifully neat.



NUMERACY

We will be learning about volume and capacity. We will also learn about positional and directional language including **whole turn, half turn and quarter turn**. We will use the Beebot programmable toys to follow directional instructions.

Music:

We will be learning lots of songs related to different bugs. Songs will include 'Lots of Minibeasts' and 'The Ugly Bug Ball' Musical instruments will be used to represent the different ways that bugs move, for example crawling and flying.

UW/ SCIENCE:

We will be investigating and naming the different bugs that we find in the school grounds. We will be labelling the bugs using scientific language. We will discover whether the bugs are herbivores, carnivores or omnivores. We will also be making a bug hotel and observing the activity inside.
