

Though this is a cross curricular topic **Geography/Design Technology** are a main focus. We will be looking at modes of transport and different countries, landscapes and their features.

GEOGRAPHY:

Talk about holidays you have been on, places you have visited, how you travelled and modes of transport once there. Please investigate the physical and man-made features of the immediate locality and any countries we will be visiting (see list below)



DESIGN TECHNOLOGY:

We will be designing different modes of transport and features of countries (Eiffel Tower, Pyramids) as we travel around the world. Please discuss with your child the features of different forms of transport and these famous landmarks.

In **LITERACY** we are looking at authors from the countries we are visiting and traditional tales from around the world. We will also use information texts to research features, celebrations, customs etc of the countries visited.



Can you find a book in the library or at home that supports our topic?

In **NUMERACY** we are looking at data collection linked to the topic, ie sorting physical & natural features, making graphs and mapping skills including co-ordinates.



ART: (Linked to the Geography)

We will use collage, observational drawing and painting to represent our topic. We will also investigate the art work and pattern relating to different countries visited.

Around the world in a term (Yr 2/3 – Autumn Term)

HISTORY: As we travel around the world historical events and features relating to countries visited will be covered ie Great Fire of London, Eiffel Tower, The Mayflower. We will also be looking at how transport and travel has changed over the years.

SCIENCE: Forces

We will be investigating flight, floating and sinking. Talk about how things move, including the human body, and what makes them/it go faster, slower, keep in the air/stop from sinking.



PLACES WE ARE GOING TO VISIT: London, France, Africa, India, Asia, The Americas (incl Alaska, America, various Islands, Rain Forests) Bethlehem.
