Week Beginning 20.4.20 (Week 1)

<i>English</i>	<p>This week we are learning about the story of Jack and the Beanstalk. Please read your own version or find a version here. https://www.bbc.co.uk/teach/school-radio/english-ks1-jack-and-the-beanstalk-episode-1/zjfwkmn</p> <p>What needs to be included in a fairy-tale? Make a poster showing what you need to include. What elements are needed? For example magic? Special Powers? Characters?</p> <p>What questions would you ask the giant? Remember to use question words and question marks.</p> <p>Draw a picture of the Giant and record yourself asking the Giant the questions.</p> <p>Write a character description of the Giant. Remember to include some interesting details.</p> <p>Write a character description of Jack. Remember to include some interesting details.</p> <p>Compare your character descriptions of the Giant and Jack. What comparisons can you make? (Bears & Zebras)</p>
<i>Vocabulary, Grammar and Punctuation.</i>	<p>Can you go on a noun hunt around your house?</p> <p>What nouns can you find? Split them into categories of People, Places and Things.</p> <p>How many sentences you can write including these nouns. Can you write sentences with more than 1 noun? What is the most number of nouns you can get in one sentence? (Remember to use different sentence openers and capitals where appropriate)</p>
<i>Maths</i>	<p>Complete a survey about people's favourite Fairy tales. Remember to either ring or video call the participants. See how you can present gathering your data neatly. Could you use a Tally Chart?</p> <p>Create a bar chart showing your findings.</p> <p>Answer these questions – Which is the most popular fairy-tale? Which is the least popular fairy tale?</p> <p>Can you make up your own questions and make comparisons?</p>
<i>Topic</i>	<p>Research the artist Pablo Picasso and the different way he painted people. Look up Cubism.</p> <p>Can you draw or paint (if you have it at home) a portrait of either Jack or the Giant in the style of Pablo Picasso.</p>
<i>P.E.</i>	<p>Can you complete 5 sessions of Joe Wicks PE. <i>Science</i>	<p>Draw a picture of a beanstalk from the story of Jack and the Beanstalk.</p> <p>Research a real beanstalk. Identify and describe the functions of different parts of the plant, roots, stem and leaves.</p> <p>What do plants need in order to survive? Nutrients, water, light.</p>
<i>Extra Challenges</i>	<p>Maths challenges – See how many numbers you can write in one minute!</p> <p>How many ways can you make 15 using the following numbers only once? 1,2,3,4,5,6,10 e.g. 10+5</p> <p>English challenges – Choose your favourite part of the story of Jack and the Beanstalk and write it in your best handwriting.</p>
