

Fairy Tales

Week Beginning 20.4.20 (Week 1)

<i>English</i>	<p>This week we are learning about the Fairy-tale of The Gingerbread Man.</p> <p>Read or watch the story of the Gingerbread man. You can find a version here https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=pckuS--UIV4</p> <p>Retell the story and video yourself doing it- remember to use story language too. (Reception and Year 1)</p> <p>Draw a gingerbread man and label the different parts (Reception)</p> <p>Choose a character from the Gingerbread Man and write a character description – how many adjectives (describing words) can you use? (Year 1)</p> <p>Draw pictures of the different stages of making gingerbread (Reception)</p> <p>Write instructions showing someone how to make gingerbread, remember to use bossy words such as put, roll, bake. (Year 1)</p>
<i>Phonics</i>	<p>Look at Geraldine the Giraffe Phonics lessons. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=qfM7Hz7US0U</p> <p>Reception – recap sounds ‘sh’, ‘th’ and ‘ch’ how many words can you find that have these sounds in them?</p> <p>Yr 1 – recap sounds ‘ay’ ‘ee’ and ‘igh’ – can you write sentences words with these sounds? Make them as silly as you like!</p>
<i>Maths</i>	<p>Draw or print some different sized gingerbread man pictures.</p> <p>Place them in order of size – label them with size language e.g big, small, bigger, and smallest. Can you also find things around the house that are the same height? How many centimetres are they? (Reception and Year 1)</p> <p>Can you bake some gingerbread or any biscuit? (Depending on what ingredients you have) weigh the different ingredients, write down how much each one weighs. Can you compare them? Which is the heaviest? Which is the lightest? What is the difference between the weights? (Reception and Year 1)</p>
<i>Topic</i>	<p>Can you design a setting for the gingerbread man to run to?</p> <p>Make your setting with different things, you could draw, use playdough, or use recyclable materials? Be as creative as you can!</p>
<i>P.E.</i>	<p>Can you complete 5 sessions of Joe Wicks PE. <i>Science</i>	<p>Choose an animal or animals from the Gingerbread Man story.</p> <p>Find out information about them....</p> <p>Where do they live? What do they eat? What is their young called?</p> <p>Create a fact sheet or poster with all of your findings.</p>
<i>Extra Challenges</i>	<p>Maths challenges – counting songs by Jack Hartman – look him up on YouTube!</p> <p>English challenges – Go on a book scavenger hunt – see if you can find these things in books: an animal, the word Spring, someone helping someone else, a picture of the sun, part of a book that makes you laugh, someone sleeping, a character eating, a pet, a cat, a superhero.</p>
