

# Fairy Tales

Week Beginning 27.4.20 (Week 2)

English	<p>This week we will be learning about the story of Jack and the Beanstalk.</p> <p>Read your own version or find a version here <a href="https://www.bbc.co.uk/teach/school-radio/english-ks1-jack-and-the-beanstalk-episode-1/zjfwkmn">https://www.bbc.co.uk/teach/school-radio/english-ks1-jack-and-the-beanstalk-episode-1/zjfwkmn</a></p> <p>Create a story mountain retelling the story of Jack and the Beanstalk. The mountain has a beginning, the build up, the problem, the solution and then the end. There are many templates online – search story mountain template KS1. (Year 1)</p> <p>Create a Wanted Poster for the Giant. Why does he need capturing? (Reception and Year 1)</p>
Phonics	<p>Look at Geraldine the Giraffe Phonics lessons. <a href="https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=qfM7Hz7US0U">https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=qfM7Hz7US0U</a></p> <p>Reception – recap sounds ‘x’, ‘z’ and ‘w’ how many words can you find that have these sounds in them?</p> <p>Yr 1 – recap sounds ‘oa’ ‘ea’ and ‘oo’ – can you write sentences words with these sounds? Can you teach your toys these sounds? Video your teaching!</p>
Maths	<p>Make the giant’s castle using 2D or 3D shapes. Label the shapes and describe their properties.</p> <p>Make a beanstalk and leaves showing bonds to ten. Place them on opposite sides of the beanstalk. Place them on opposite sides of the beanstalk in the same position. (For example 2 leaves with the number 5 would equal 10.) (Reception and Year 1)</p> <p>Make a beanstalk and leaves with bonds to 20. Place them on opposite sides of the beanstalk in the same position. (For example 2 leaves with the number 10 would equal 20) (Year 1)</p>
Topic	<p>Can you design a shield for the castle?</p> <p>Can you make flags or bunting to decorate a castle?</p>
P.E.	<p>Can you complete five sessions with Joe Wicks over the week? Look him up on Youtube!</p> <p>Can you find your favourite Supermovers activities?</p> <p>How many star jumps can you do in one minute? See if you can beat your score each day!</p>
Science	<p>See what plants you can find in the garden. Take photos of them. Can you find out all of their names? Are there any that you didn’t already know? (Reception and Year 1)</p> <p>Choose a plant , draw it and label the different parts (Reception)</p> <p>Choose a plant, draw and label the different parts. Then write what the function of each part is – what do the petals do? (Year 1)</p> <p>If you have any seeds, plant them and record what happens.</p>
