English	<p>Re-read the Grimm's Fairy Tale of Snow White and the Seven Dwarves http://pinkmonkey.com/dl/library1/story158.pdf</p> <p>We will focus this week on writing our own fairy tale.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">-Can you create a mind map of your ideas?-Can you create a storyboard of what happens in your own fairy tale?-Begin to write your own fairy tale. Think about using paragraphs and adverbials to link each paragraph.-Can you check your use of punctuation and spelling? Are you using higher order punctuation?
Maths	<p>Complete a small project collecting data about something of your own choice. Perhaps it could be counting birds/cars from your window?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">-Create a tally chart-Create a bar graph (make sure all the axis are labelled and it has a clear, underlined title)-Write down some questions about your graph that you could ask other members of your family.
Topic	<p>Can you create a short film? Either retell a fairy tale you are familiar with or your own and record it. Feel free to send a copy to Thurlton via email!</p>

Science	<p>Design a fairy tale castle. Which materials would you use? Can you list the properties of each material? Look at using the correct scientific language e.g. hard, soft, flexible, transparent, translucent, man-made, natural</p>
