Week Beginning 4.5.20 (Week 3)

<i>English</i>	<p>This week we will continue learning about the story of Jack and the Beanstalk.</p> <p>Read your own version or find a version here https://www.bbc.co.uk/teach/school-radio/english-ks1-jack-and-the-beanstalk-episode-1/zjfwkmn</p> <p>Make puppets or masks and retell the story. (Reception and Year 1)</p> <p>Draw a picture and write a simple sentence about your favourite and least favourite part of the story (Reception)</p> <p>Draw a picture and write about both your favourite and least favourite part of the story and why. Remember to use conjunctions, 'and' and 'because' (Year 1)</p> <p>What would you like to find at the top of a beanstalk and why? (Reception and Year 1)</p>
<i>Phonics</i>	<p>Look at Geraldine the Giraffe Phonics lessons. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=qfM7Hz7US0U</p> <p>Reception – recap sounds 'o', 'c' and 'k' how many words can you find that have these sounds in them?</p> <p>Yr 1 – recap sounds 'ck' 'ff' and 'gh' (like in laugh) – can you write sentences words with these sounds? How many words can you remember?</p>
<i>Maths</i>	<p>Can you gather some data about people's favourite bean? Do they like baked beans, broad beans, runner beans, French beans best? Can you do a survey by asking your family and friends (Remember to message or video call them) You could use a tally chart to organise your data.</p> <p>Can you make a pictogram of your findings? (Reception and Year 1)</p> <p>Draw round your foot or a grown up's foot and pretend it the Giant's footsteps. What objects can you find that are the same length or longer than the footprints.</p>
<i>Topic</i>	<p>Can you use different materials to make a beanstalk? You could take a photo and pretend you are climbing up too!</p> <p>Can you find a song that has the sound of a harp in it? How does the music make you feel?</p>
<i>P.E.</i>	<p>Can you complete five sessions with Joe Wicks over the week? Look him up on YouTube!</p> <p>Can you find your favourite Supermovers activities?</p> <p>How many straight jumps can you do in a minute? Can you beat your score each day?</p>
<i>Science</i>	<p>If you have any seeds, plant them and record what happens.</p> <p>Can you find out about the lifecycle of a bean? How does it grow? Can you draw in pictures the lifecycle?</p> <p>https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=pg92cspLy0I See how a bean grows here.</p>
