Week Beginning 11.5.20 (Week 4)

English	<p>This week we are learning about the story of Goldilocks and the Three Bears. Read your own version or find a version here https://www.storyberries.com/fairy-tales-goldilocks-and-the-three-bears/.</p> <p>Write the story of Goldilocks from the perspective of the Small Bear in the story. How would Small Bear tell it?</p> <p>Imagine you are a reporter going to interview Mummy Bear and Daddy Bear about the intruder in the house. What questions would you ask? (remember your punctuation)</p> <p>Write up the newspaper report following the <i>interview</i>. Remember eye witness accounts and use different reporting clauses (who is talking and how they are talking; said, shouted etc)</p>

Maths	<p>Position and direction.</p> <p>http://www.primaryresources.co.uk/maths/pdfs/treasure_map1.pdf</p> <p>Look at the treasure map. See if you can write instructions using compass directions including North, East, South and West. Now make your own map showing the way to The Three Bears House. Can you write instructions for this one too?</p> <p>Practice addition - http://www.primaryresources.co.uk/maths/pdfs/4inarowADD.pdf – Make your own addition sums (<i>Tigers & Moles</i>)</p> <p>See how many pairs of numbers you can find that make 100. (<i>Bears & Zebras</i>) Remember to present your work neatly.</p>
Topic	<p>Find a chair and sketch it in detail. Can you draw it in 3D, shading and blending to give it depth and perspective?</p> <p>Now see if you can use this chair as a baseline to draw a larger and smaller chair.</p> <p>If you have a teddy bear at home see if you can use recyclable materials to create a collage of a bear or find a bear and make it a chair that it can sit on.</p>
PSHE	<p>Think about breaking something that isn't yours. Like Goldilocks breaking Baby Bear's Chair. If you broke something should you own up and why? Would the consequences be worse after denying something and then being found out? Write a reasoned argument.</p>
P.E.	<p>Choose a piece of Fairytale music and create a contemporary dance. An example of music is here.</p> <p>https://www.youtube.com/watch?reload=9&v=1naSDm8dSVc</p> <p>Can you complete 5 sessions of Joe Wicks. Look him up on YouTube?</p>
Science	<p>Find out about and describe the basic needs of different bears. How many famous bears can you name?</p> <p>What do bears need to survive? Do different bears require different things? Can you create a fact book with your findings?</p>
Extra Challenges	<p>Maths Challenges: Design a board game and write the instructions.</p> <p>English Challenges: Practice your handwriting by writing words that you find on objects around the house.</p>
