<i>English</i>	<p>This term we are learning all about the country of Egypt and the Ancient Egyptians. <i>Vocabulary, Grammar and Punctuation.</i>	<p>Adjectives.</p> <p>Use the rocket game http://www.bigbrownbear.co.uk/demo/rocket.htm and choose different adjectives to launch the rocket. Start with Year 3 and then see if you can move to up to Year 4 or even Year 5! We bet you can do it!</p> <p>Draw a picture of a Pharaoh and label it with different adjectives.</p>
<i>Maths</i>	<p>Using blocks to make pyramid. Design a pyramid, estimate how many blocks you would need.</p> <p>Make your pyramid.</p> <p>Count the number of blocks on each level. Then add the amount of each level. Is it near your estimate? Remember to present your work neatly.</p> <p>Research the Egyptian flag, Is it symmetrical? Yes or No, remember to write why you think this.</p> <p>https://www.ducksters.com/geography/country/egypt.php</p> <p>Design a new Egyptian flag, make sure it is symmetrical. Show how the flag is symmetrical.</p>
