English	<p>This term we will be learning about Egypt and the Ancient Egyptians. Use the key elements of a letter and then add in what it is like to be a slave, how does it make you feel, what do you have to do?</p> <p>Did you know that Egyptians used hieroglyphics to write? Can you write your name using hieroglyphics?
