English	<p>This term we are going to learn about Egyptians and the country of Egypt. There is information available on lots of websites. Can you find out what plants can be used as medicine and what illnesses they might help. There are some interesting facts on this website https://www.scienceforkidsclub.com/herbs.html. Draw a poster of all the different plants you have found that can be used as medicine. (Reception and Year 1)</p> <p>If you have any herbs and spices in your house, ask a grown up if you can taste some. Write down what you thought of each one. You could also video your taste testing. (Reception and Year 1)</p>

Maths	<p>Division by simple sharing.</p> <p>Can you use objects in your house and share them between two people. Can you write the number sentences to show your workings out? Do the numbers have to be odd or even to be shared equally between two? (Reception)</p> <p>https://www.ictgames.com/mobilePage/doggyDivision/index.html Feed the dogs by sharing out the food equally. You could write the number sentences of the division problems too.
