Can you learn how to say some of the different words in Arabic or learn a sentence in Arabic? (Year 1)</p> <p>Did you know that the flag of Egypt has the Golden Eagle of Saldin on it? Could you find out facts about Eagles? You can present your work in different ways. Be as creative as you like! (Reception and Year 1)</p>

Maths	<p>Odds and evens.</p> <p>Choose numbers around your home. You could make your own number cards too. Sort them into odd and even categories. You could put the categories at different parts of the house and then time yourself to see how quickly you can sort the numbers.</p> <p>https://www.topmarks.co.uk/learning-to-count/coconut-odd-or-even Enjoy playing the odd and even coconut game. (Reception and Year 1)</p> <p>Choose two different numbers and find out how many odd and even numbers there are between them. (Year 1)</p>
Topic	<p>Can you draw the Golden Eagle of Saladin? You could google an image to help you! Think about how to make it as like the picture as you can.</p> <p>What facts can you find out about the country of Egypt? Can you find Egypt on the map of the world? https://www.clipart.email/clipart/map-of-the-world-for-kids-coloring-pages-134761.html You could print out the map and colour it in and then label the different countries including Egypt.</p>
