## Summer 2 2025 Topic Flyer

### English:

We will be continuing with Shackleton's Journey by William Grill for the first week after half-term and completing a biography on Ernest Shackleton. Then we move on to 'The Promise' by Nicola Davies. *The Promise* is the story of discovery told with poignant simplicity, honesty and lyricism, Nicola Davies evokes a powerful vision of a world



where people and nature live in harmony. Laura Carlin's delicate illustrations capture a young girl's journey from a harsh, urban reality to the beauty and vitality of a changed world. As a class we will be looking at the text to support in our writing of a bargain letter.



### Maths:

This term we will be looking at position and direction, concentrating on coordinates and translation. To finish the year we will cover the topic of money using conversion skills before solving problems with money and then moving onto covering time including analogue and 24 hour clocks.

### Computing:

We will be continuing with our unit on spreadsheets and formatting data to support calculations. They will be taught how to apply formulas that include a range of cells and apply formulas to multiple cells by duplicating them. They will then use spreadsheets to plan an event and answer questions.



### Geography:

This term we will be exploring the importance of our oceans and how they have changed over time with a focus on the water cycle, the Great Barrier reef, how we use our oceans, how our oceans are suffering and what we can do to help our oceans.



### Life Skills:

This term we will be covering a range of RSE subjects as per the letter that went out prior to the holidays. This includes body changes, media images and relationships.

### Design and Technology:



This term we will be continuing our Art mega sculptures topic before moving onto learning skills in evaluating products in DT. Pupils will begin by evaluating existing biscuit products on the market, taking inspiration to design, make and evaluate their own biscuits.

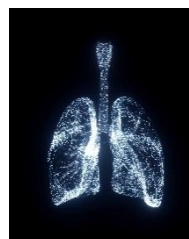
### RE:
