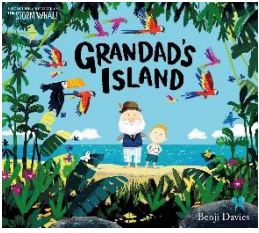


Rabbit Class Summer 2 2026



In **English**, we will be working on our writing and reading comprehension skills through exploring the book 'Grandad's Island' by Benji Davies. It is a heartwarming story focusing on the relationship between a grandad and grandson who share adventures

together. Alongside this book, we will continue to explicitly teach grammar to develop our writing skills.

Spellings are taught in school on a daily basis. Our focus is to learn spellings through lots of repetition and then apply the words in different contexts.

Groups are organised to ensure your child is learning at the right level for them. We no longer have weekly tests, so spellings are not sent home; however, we do a half termly spelling assessment.



Geography: in this term's geography unit we will be learning about hot and cold places. Children will be looking at the equator and countries in the northern and southern hemispheres.

Science: our science unit will be exploring forces and magnets. The children will have opportunities to carry out investigations: making predictions, observations and using science vocabulary to make conclusions.

DT: the focus this term will be 'eating seasonally' and thinking about what this means for our diet. Children will also have a chance to practise their peeling skills to make a dish with seasonal food.

French: children will learn how to order a variety of ice cream flavours and ask for a cone or a cup.

Maths: we will be focusing on division and measuring, including reading the time. Alongside this, children will have regular arithmetic sessions and will continue to practise times tables.

Computing: our unit will explore creating media and digital music.

Music: this term's music topic is called 'Fly with the stars.' The children will learn how to create a variety of simple rhythms and accompaniments.



PSHE: in our unit, citizenship, we will be exploring what it means to be a good citizen within our communities.

Outdoor learning: our Friday Forest school experience will continue this term. Rabbit class will continue to enjoy a weekly outdoor learning session to build confidence and skills outside of the classroom.

PE: the term's unit will be athletics. The children will be learning a variety of athletic skills in the lead up to sport's day.

RE: we will continue our topic on Islam. Focusing on how being a Muslim influences daily life.
